Food for Fines!

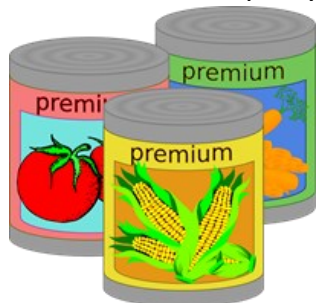
In honor of National Library Week (April 8th-14th)

In celebration of the Montana women's suffrage centennial, join suffragette, temperance worker, dress reformer & journalist Mary Long Alderson for a conversation. This first person presentation invites the audience into a 1914 Montana parlor to discourse on the issues of the day.
